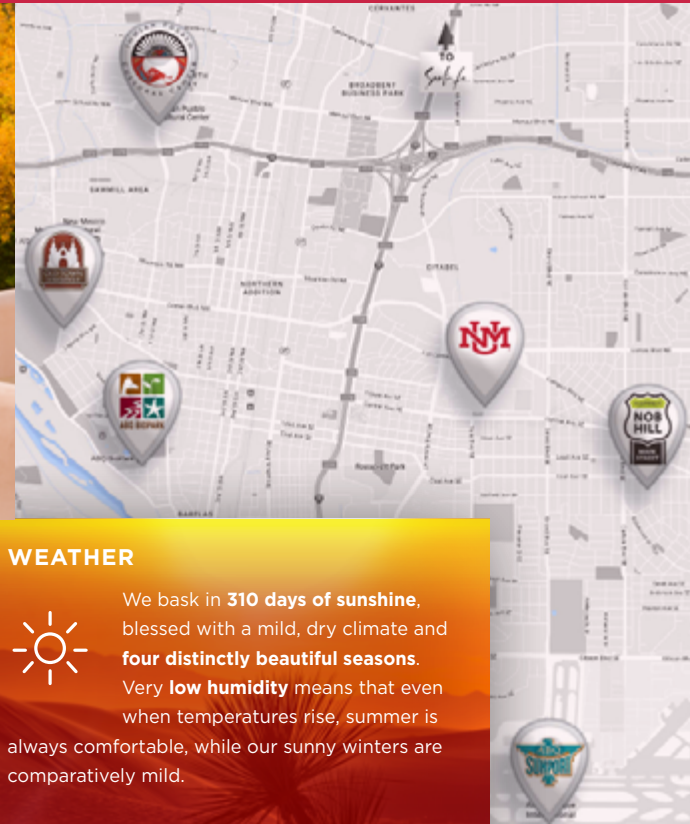


## AND A LITTLE BIT MORE.

### LOCATION

The University of New Mexico campus is a great urban location, less than 5 miles from the Albuquerque International Sunport. It is centrally-located within the city while being close to many local attractions.



### WEATHER



We bask in **310 days of sunshine**, blessed with a mild, dry climate and **four distinctly beautiful seasons**.

Very **low humidity** means that even when temperatures rise, summer is always comfortable, while our sunny winters are comparatively mild.

Our average annual rainfall is about 9 in.  
The average relative humidity is only 44%.

### NOB HILL

Within walking distance of UNM is Nob Hill, a vibrant neighborhood full of restaurants, bars, coffee shops, an independent movie theater, and plenty of shopping. Located along Rt. 66, Albuquerque's original main street features a mixture of architecture that is appealing to the motorist including the neighborhood shopper.

### OLD TOWN

Just west of Downtown, you'll find Historic Old Town - Albuquerque's cultural center touting 10 blocks of historic adobe buildings. Old Town features a Plaza, small shops, galleries, museums, local restaurants as well as the Aquarium, Botanical Gardens, and the Rio Grande Zoo.

### UPTOWN

Only 4 miles from UNM, Albuquerque Uptown is a modern shopping and business district featuring everything from boutiques, local eateries to nationally recognized department stores and restaurants. The hub of the district is a pedestrian-friendly, open-air shopping, dining and entertainment venue.

### OUR CAMPUS IS AN ARBORETUM

### GRAND BALLROOM

The **11,000 sq. ft. Grand Ballroom** at the SUB is an elegant space for any wedding, banquet or reception. The space can also be divided into 3 smaller rooms to fit your conference needs.



### MEETING ROOMS

The Student Union Building offers **21 meeting spaces**, which can be customized to your individual requirements. The meeting rooms along with the **Ballrooms can host up to 2,000 event attendees.**

### CLASSROOMS

As an institution of higher education, UNM touts a variety of **classrooms and auditoriums** that facilitate collaboration, discussion, along with presenting of information.



### TECHNOLOGY
